Since 2007, Xuanwu Hospital began to train the foreign doctors from developing countries. From 2012 to 2018, it has organized 10 seminars which received 284 neurosurgeons, neurologists and officials from 50 countries around the world. From those seminars, all the participants think they get a lot of experiences about the technology and management while they learn much about Chinese culture and make many good Chinese friends.</p>
<p>Training Course Content</p>	<p>Purpose: Morbidity rate and mortality rate of cerebrovascular diseases remain high, and low quality of life of the patients and the high cost of treatment brings huge burden for many countries especially the developing countries. Cerebrovascular diseases, as a major problem in the world field, have become an important cause of death and disability, often result in paralysis and movement disorders, language and comprehension dysfunction, thinking, emotional control and memory loss, and depression and other psychological diseases.</p> <p>The improvement of the level of prevention and treatment of cerebrovascular diseases is related to the national economy and the people's livelihood, and developing countries have an urgent need for training in this area. This seminar organized by Xuanwu Hospital of Capital Medical University, which has strong academic expertise and rich and international training capabilities, will help to strengthen the tie between China and other developing countries, and support other developing countries to improve the livelihood of their people.</p> <p>Content: The seminar includes 3 sections namely presentation, field trip, and hand-on microsurgical training. All presentations are given by famous experts or government officials, covering topics on the management, prevention, treatment and rehabilitation of cerebrovascular diseases. Participants will attend 2019 WFNS Special World Congress in Beijing where they will have opportunity to listen to the lectures and communicate with world famous neurosurgical masters face to face. This course will discuss many topics of neurosurgical diseases from different perspective.</p> <p>On the field trip, the participants will go to Huhehaote and Dalate in Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region to meet with the staff of the local hospital. Besides, this seminar will also provide the participants with hand on microsurgical training, enabling them to practice the microsurgical techniques by themselves on rats.
