About the Project

Background: As an important pillar for economic and social development, infrastructure is marked by its strategic, fundamental and pioneering significance. Infrastructure connectivity, therefore, could facilitate the development of trade and technology, optimize the regional economic structure, expand the economic scale and market, and thus improve people's living standards. Since the launch of the Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) 10 years ago, China, taking advantages of its own experience in development and technology strengths, has helped the developing countries along the Belt and Road implement a great many of infrastructure projects and thus promote their connectivity and integration into the global value chains, so that they can truly enjoy the benefits delivered by a robust global economy. Under the BRI framework, China will continue to improve and upgrade the infrastructure connectivity system and support the

infrastructure connectivity construction among developing countries so as to help them achieve high-quality development in a consistent, equitable, and sustainable manner.

**Purpose**: The seminar aims share China's experience in infrastructure connectivity practices so that other developing countries can have a better understanding of China's achievements in infrastructure construction since China launched the reform and opening up policy. In this way, the seminar would lay a good groundwork for China and other developing countries to carry out pragmatic cooperation in infrastructure construction, and thus further promoting the transportation infrastructure connectivity and deepening the friendly relations between China and other developing countries..

Content: The seminar will give lectures mainly on topics such as overview of China's national conditions, China's experience in reform, opening up and economic development, the Global Development Initiative (GDI), the development of China's high-speed railways and the economics of high-speed railways, the development of China's urban transportation infrastructure: numbers and cases, introduction to the IT-based construction of China's railways, smart city and smart transportation, the development and current status of big data industry, infrastructure construction cooperation in China, etc.

**Method**: The seminar will invite Chinese experts in the field of infrastructure construction to give themed lectures; organize discussions and exchanges between participants and experts, and among participants; organize study tours to relevant enterprises in Beijing and other cities to allow participants to experience the process of China's local economic development, witness China's achievements in infrastructure connectivity construction, and feel the local customs across China.

(The above is based on the preliminary schedule, and may be adjusted according to the actual situation. The final version will be provided upon arrival in China.)

- 1. Please prepare your passport, Chinese visa and third-party transit country visa (if necessary) before coming to China.

- 4. After picking up the luggage, please wait patiently at the international arrival exit (or domestic arrival exit) and the organizer will pick you up with a pick-up board with your name on it. If waiting for more than 15 minutes, you can communicate with the organizer by phone.

- 5. In case of lost baggage so you need to register the loss procedure with the airline, please first communicate with the organizer to confirm the baggage delivery location and then fill in the registration form.
- 6. Dress Code: Participants should pay attention to the weather conditions during the Seminar and bring appropriate clothes. Participants should wear formal clothes (national costumes are also acceptable) for important activities in the Seminar.
