<p style="text-align: center;">Seminar Content</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">1.Main Training Contents</p> <p>(1) China’s national conditions: the overall introduction of China’s political system, history, society.</p> <p>(2) “Belt and Road” initiative: main contents, values, and practice of “Belt and Road” initiative.</p> <p>(3) Community poverty alleviation and Post-disaster reconstruction work of the RCSC: Sharing RCSC’s working experience in poverty alleviation, the community resilience improvement working methods, successful cases for post-disaster reconstruction, etc.</p> <p>(4) The disaster management system and post-disaster reconstruction work mechanism of the Chinese government: introduce natural disasters in China, construction of a legal framework, institutions and mechanisms related to disaster reduction, public participation in disaster reduction, post-disaster reconstruction and international cooperation.</p> <p>(5) Post-disaster reconstruction working experience sharing: sharing the working experience of the satellite remote sensing technology supports post-disaster reconstruction information survey and collection.</p> <p>(6)Disaster management of RCSC: introduce the positioning and strategy of disaster management, disaster response system and components, disaster relief resource preparation and Post-disaster reconstruction work of RCSC.</p> <p>(7) RCSC’s International humanitarian cooperation and assistance work of RCSC: share mechanisms and relief practices of international cooperation and post-disaster humanitarian assistance work of RCSC against COVID-19 & other emergency events.</p> <p>(8) Disaster relief fundraising and fund management mechanism of the RCSC.</p> <p>(9) Sharing of work experience of the Fraternity Project of the Red Cross Society of China in Helping Post-disaster Reconstruction.</p> <p>(10) First aid knowledge and skills: lectures and demonstration of first aid knowledge and skills, including basic knowledge on cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), CPR procedures and skills, how to use automatic external defibrillator (AED), causes, determination, symptoms, first aid skills of airway foreign body obstruction (AFBO), first aid for trauma, etc.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">2. Discussion and Exchange</p> <p>(1) Participants exchange their thoughts on post-disaster reconstruction work with related experts from RCSC.</p> <p>(2) Participants discuss the current challenges and related cases of post-disaster reconstruction work in their own countries.</p> <p>(3) Participants share & exchange the history, culture and national conditions of their own country with each other.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">3. Field Visit</p> <p>(1) During the stay in Beijing, all the participants will be organized to visit the Disaster Preparedness and Relief Center of the Red Cross Society of China, the Life Safety Experiencing Classroom of RCSC, the China Fire Museum, the National Earthquake Emergency Rescue Training Base, etc.</p> <p>(2) During the stay in Ningxia Hui Autonomous Region, all the participants will be organized to visit the Disaster Preparedness and Relief Center of RCSC Ningxia Branch, Ningxia Red Cross First Aid Training Base, etc.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">4. Cultural Experience</p> <p>(1) Chinese cultural experience: Chinese learning.</p> <p>(2) Chinese history, culture and social life experience: Through the tour of the Forbidden City, the Great Wall, the Summer Palace, Qianmen and other historical and cultural sites, and the experience of the Xiushui, Hongqiao market and other commodity markets, to understand the heritage of Chinese culture, local customs, experience the real life of ordinary Chinese people.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">5. Team Building Activities</p> <p>(1) Ice-breaking: participants will be invited to carry out fun team building activities to get familiar with each other.</p> <p>(2) Seminar instruction: main objectives, detailed arrangements and other information of the seminar will be introduced to the participants to help them know more about the seminar. Meanwhile, training needs and questionnaires will be collected.</p> <p>(3) Summing-up meeting: comments & suggestions will be highly appreciated and collected from the participants in the end of the seminar.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">6.
