About the Project

Content: The Seminar will give lectures on various topics such as an overview of China's national conditions, China's experience in reform and opening-up and economic development, the implementation of Belt and Road Initiatives (BRI) and the Global Development Initiatives (GDI), Chinese path to modernization, build a global community of shared future for mankind, the management system of electromechanical industry in China, the outbound trade, business and trade cooperation of China's electromechanical products, national science and technology strategy and technological innovation, the medium and long-term planning of economic and social development, industrial transformation and upgrading path, the development trend in the digital era, etc.

Method: The seminar will invite Chinese experts in the field of electromechanical industry to give themed lectures on various special topics; organize exchanges and discussions between participants and experts, and among participants; organize study tours to relevant enterprises in Beijing and other cities to allow participants to experience the process of China's local economic development, witness China's achievements in electromechanical industry, and feel the local customs across China.
