Training Content	The seminar will be held in Beijing, China and adopt a combination of lectures, case studies, and group discussions. The lectures will tentatively include: the core essence, connotation, and extension of Thought on Ecological Civilization; policies outlined in China's "Integrated Plan for Ecological Conservation"; institutional framework and specific methods of ecological conservation; technologies and supporting measures for ecological conservation; paths and models through which China's ecological civilization construction promotes green development and increases income; international cooperation highlights under the initiative of "Building a Shared Future for All Life on Earth"; the significance of forestry in ecological conservation; the transformation paths and models of "Lucid waters and lush mountains are invaluable assets"; low-carbon, green, and circular economic development models; Thought on Ecological Civilization and the Global Development Initiative; China's ecological conservation practices guided by ecological civilization theory. Additionally, the program will include field visits to Hangzhou, Huzhou, and Jinhua and other cities in Zhejiang province. The seminar will arrange country report and group discussion sessions and the participants are advised to prepare materials in advance. In country report section, the tentative outline for sharing is as follows: general introduction to the participating country in geographical, cultural, societal and other aspects; ecological progress and institutional system building. In discussion session, there are different topics. For the topic of exploring bilateral cooperation, we will set up a discussion between National Forestry and Grassland Administration of China (highest forestry authorities in China) and participating countries. Participants are advised to know the current situations and challenges of forestry cooperation between participating countries and China and think about the possibility of expanding cooperation.
