<p>Training Course Content</p>	<p>Seminar on criminal investigation for officers from developing countries is the university's characteristic brand for foreign police officers. Since 2007, the university has successfully held 11 criminal investigation and criminal investigation technology seminars for developing countries in Asia, Africa, and Latin America. By holding this seminar, we wish to establish a multilateral police exchanging and cooperation platform with developing countries and promote the exchange of cutting-edge criminal investigation technology among participated countries and enhance law enforcement cooperation relationships among these countries and to enhance the exchange between law enforcement officers.</p> <p>Through these lectures, discussions, and field visits, the seminar intends to systematically and comprehensively introduce the general condition of China and the achievements made since the reform and opening-up policy, as well as present Xi Jinping's thought on diplomacy, policing system and judicial system of China. The seminar will also arrange professional and technical lectures on crime scene investigation, China's practice in combating organized crime, intelligence-led policing, China's drug control and international cooperation, cyber-crime investigation and digital data collecting technology, China's anti-terrorism situation and national anti-terrorism measures, video investigation technology, Construction of social security prevention and control system and analysis of credit card crime and countermeasures, Analysis of explosive devices and its remnants etc. These lectures will enhance the participants' understanding of policing work in China and Chinese traditional culture.</p> <p>The seminar will also arrange students to visit police departments of "Pearl of Peace" international law enforcement exchange and cooperation window departments and cultural sites. During the visit to Jinan and Tai'an, Shandong Province, besides the experience of the etiquette culture and natural geographical scenery, it is also planned to arrange a visit to Jinan Police Museum and the Criminal Investigation Institute of the Jinan Public Security Bureau and also Caiyuan Police station of Tai'an Public Security Bureau to help the participants to understand the historical development of</p>

	<p>Chinese police and the current development of criminal investigation technology and the working pattern in police stations in China; In Beijing, it is planned to visit historical and cultural sites such as the Great Wall and the Forbidden City, and it's also planned a field visit to the second research institution of the MPS to experience the construction and application of cutting-edge technology in the national forensic science laboratories. Through these visits, the participants could experience the achievements of "Ping An China" construction by themselves.</p>
<p>About the Organizer</p>	<p>Founded in May 1948, the Criminal Investigation Police University of China (CIPUC) is an institution of higher education subordinated to the Ministry of Public Security of P.R.China. In 1981, the university has become the first public security institution to carry out undergraduate education of public security in China. In the past 75 years, more than 180,000 graduates from CIPUC became officers, specialists and professionals for judicial and public security organs, which made important contribution to the development of the public security work and "Security China". There are 7 secondary teaching schools and 3 secondary management schools in the university. At present, there are 3 first-level disciplines including Law, Science of Public Security, and Technology of Public Security, 1 second-level discipline which is Forensic Medicine, 4 professional master's degrees including Juris Master, Master of Policing, Master of Applied Psychology and Master of Public Administration, which form a disciplinary system with distinctive public security characteristics based on engineering, science and law. First-level discipline of Technology of Public Security and first-level discipline of Science of Public Security were both successfully selected into the list of "the first-class discipline construction project in Liaoning Province". The university is one of the first batch of authorized units for master's degree in public security science and public security technology. The university has 12 undergraduate majors, including Criminal Investigation, Public Order Management, Economic Crime Investigation, Narcotics Control, Criminal Intelligence, International Policing Studies, Police Canine Training, Technical Investigation, Anti-terrorism Policing, Forensic Science, Forensic Audio and Video Technology, and Cyber Security and Law Enforcement, covering the main fields of public security. Among these undergraduate majors, 10 were selected as the national first-class undergraduate major construction point, 1 was selected as the provincial first-class undergraduate major construction point, and 5 were selected as the provincial first-class undergraduate education demonstration specialties. There are 774 teaching and administrative staff, including 103 staff with senior professional titles and 218 staff with deputy senior professional titles. There are 3 staff awarded Government Special Subsidy of the State Council, 10 staff awarded Ministry-level Subsidy of the Ministry of Public Security, 1 staff selected into the new century talent support plan of the Ministry of Education, 1 national exemplary individual in popular science work, 1 national outstanding teacher in network security, 3 national exemplary individual in public security science and technology, 2 national outstanding police, 22 criminal technology experts in public security organs, 16 outstanding teachers in national public security education system, 4 teachers with outstanding achievements in public security education, 1 expert in interrogation and case handling of the Criminal Investigation Department of the Ministry of Public Security, 15 famous teachers at provincial and ministerial levels, 6 outstanding experts in Liaoning Province, 8 outstanding teachers in Liaoning Province, 8 outstanding</p>
