The National Judges College (NJC) is an institution directly affiliated to the Supreme People's Court and a main institution for education and training of judges in China. Founded in 1997, NJC is located at No. 111, West Road of South 4th Ring Road, Huaxiang, Fengtai District, Beijing. It covers an area of 165,400 m² and a floor area of 60,000 m². It can carry out training for 750 people at the same time. NJC primarily undertakes appointment training, reappointment training, promotion training and trial-oriented training for presidents, vice-presidents of China's high people's courts and intermediate people's courts as well as senior judges and reserve talents from all levels people's courts. Besides, it also provides pre-job training for expectant judges. In the 19 years since its establishment, NJC has held more than 1,200 judges training program, with the growing speed of 150 training program per year. More than 200,000 judges and court staff received training in NJC. Since the great progress has been made, it was praised by the Supreme People's Court in 2011, 2013, 2014 and 2018, and was awarded by the Supreme People's Court with third-class merits in 2015.

NJC has a high quality full-time and part-time faculty, with 43 full-time teachers, including 10 professors, 21 associate professors and 12 lecturers. At the same time, 304 part-time professors are employed from all levels people's courts, nationwide teaching and scientific research institutions and government institutions. For now, NJC has set up 33 branches in provinces, autonomous regions and municipalities nationwide.

The National Judges College is an important window for communication with foreign countries of the Supreme People's Court and also serves as "the International Exchange Center for Judges of the Supreme People's Court". In order to cooperate with the construction of the Belt and Road, from 2016 to 2021, NJC has held 53 seminars for judges from abroad, training 1,173 judicial officials from 58 countries and regions.
