About the Seminar

To facilitate a sustainable development path with core competitiveness for the construction industry, it is necessary to update, transform and upgrade the whole industrial chain under the leadership of digital technology and the effective support of information means, with new construction industrialization as the core through the deep integration of greening, industrialization and informationization. At present, there is an urgent need for the international community to join hands, follow the development trends of informatization, digitalization, networking and intelligence, profoundly grasp the development trends of human society entering the information age and moving toward digital civilization, and fully understand the importance and far-reaching impact of creating a good digital ecology in the construction industry.

**Purpose**: Digital ecology is highly globalized, and open cooperation and mutual benefit are the important connotation of creating a good digital ecology. China has been actively participating

in international cooperation on digitalization in the construction industry and is willing to work with other developing countries to shoulder the historical responsibility of making progress for mankind, and build a digital cooperation pattern in the construction industry, making the digital civilization in the construction industry benefit all peoples. This Seminar aims to help developing countries cultivate construction talents with digital skills, improve the digital capacity and level of the construction industry, and promote high-quality development and the construction of a community of a shared future for mankind.

Content: The topics of the Seminar mainly includes the overview of China's national conditions, Chinese leaders' philosophy of governance, common values of China and the world, China's experience of reform and opening-up and economic development, the Belt and Road initiative and implementation measures, China's digital development of construction projects, opportunities and challenges of digital transformation in the construction industry, the construction industry and artificial intelligence, the application of Internet of Things in the construction industry, green low-carbon building and sustainable development, the construction of smart cities in the era of digital economy, *etc*.

**Modes**: Experts in the field of digital development of China's construction industry are invited to give lectures on various topics; exchanges and discussions are organized between participants and experts and among participants; field trips are arranged to visit digital-related enterprises in the construction industry in Beijing and other city/cities.

- 5. In case of lost baggage so you need to register the loss procedure with the airline, please first

- communicate with the organizer to confirm the baggage delivery location and then fill in the registration form.
- 6. Dress Code: Participants should pay attention to the weather conditions during the Seminar and bring appropriate clothes. Participants should wear formal clothes (national costumes are also acceptable) for important activities in the Seminar.
