- (14) Food packaging and contact materials and food safety:It introduces the impact of food packaging and contact materials on food safety, as well as the detection technology of toxic and harmful substances in food packaging and contact materials.
- (15) Detection of biotoxin in grain:It introduces the basic knowledge of biotoxin, the key technical points in the detection process and the key points of quality control.
- (16) Detection of routine items in grain:The detection standards and technologies of nitrite, cyanide and fluoride are introduced.
- (17) Detection of GM in grain:It introduces the basic knowledge of transgenic detection, the key control points and quality control points of transgenic detection in grain.
