Introduction of training content	I.Introduction of main training courses The seminar mainly includes public courses, lectures and seminars. The public course mainly introduces the national conditions of China and the experience and stories of China's pandemic prevention and control. The lectures introduce the current situation of China's agricultural development, agricultural capacity cooperation policies, and agricultural trade in conjunction with the theme of the training course. (1) China's national conditions: mainly introduces Chinese history and folk culture. (2) China's pandemic prevention and control: mainly introducing the relevant initiatives in fighting the COVID-19. (3) International production capacity cooperation policies: Introduce the policies implemented by China to promote international production capacity cooperation, various multi-bilateral financial policies for international production capacity cooperation, as well as the service guarantee, risk prevention and control system established, etc. (4) Introduction of the "Belt and Road" Initiative and the Construction of Free Trade Zone: Analysis of the relationship between China and the world, the international economic situation, challenges in the new era, with emphasis on the introduction of the "Belt and Road" Initiative and the strategy of the Free Trade Zone. (5) Main contents and progress of international production capacity cooperation: Introduce the six				

results achieved so far.

- (6) Agricultural products trade: Introduce the import and export of agricultural products trade and related policies, the monitoring ways of Chinese Customs for imported goods and related personnel, cross-border e-commerce import Customs clearance, inspection and quarantine considerations, etc.
- (7) International agricultural park construction and management: Introduce the advantages and development overview of agricultural parks, international agricultural park construction planning and successful cases.
- (8) Automatic production mode and practice of agricultural management application platform: Introduce agricultural mechanization and automation innovation practice as well as operation mode and management.
- (9) Water and fertilizer integration technology and practice: Introduction to drip irrigation under the film, facility operation procedures, drip fertilizer selection, water and fertilizer management and other technologies.
- (10) International Cooperation in Agricultural Industry Development and Poverty Alleviation: Introduction to the current sustainable agricultural development in China, the main business models of agricultural industry, and the importance of promoting poverty reduction and development through international cooperation in agricultural industry.

2. Cloud tour introduction

The video of the visit to Yangling Smart Agricultural Industrial Park and Agricultural Products E-commerce Industrial Park will be played to learn modern agricultural production technology on site, understand new ways and modes of international cooperation in the field of agricultural industry, and deepen the understanding of the lecture content.

3. Introduction to the seminar

The participants will be invited to make national reports on the theme of agricultural development and production capacity cooperation of their own countries, and famous domestic experts in related fields will be invited to preside over. Representatives of enterprises from China and participating countries will be invited to conduct in-depth exchanges on production capacity cooperation issues such as trade in agricultural products, introduction of agricultural machinery and equipment, import and export of pesticides and fertilizers.

Note: The above course content is subject to the actual schedule.

Teaching method: Online lecture.

Lecture time: In principle, two lectures or seminars of two hours each will be arranged for each working day.

4. Introduction of the lecturers

The lecturers are mainly from Northwest Agriculture and Forestry University, Xi'an Jiaotong University and Shaanxi Provincial Party School. Lecturers have rich research and practical experiences in agricultural industry development and production capacity cooperation, which can ensure high quality and efficient completion of teaching.

5. Participants need to prepare materials

In order to facilitate the seminar and exchanges, please prepare materials related to the theme of the seminar, such as: ① Basic national conditions: the basic situation of your country, the development of your country's agricultural industry, etc.; ② Introduction of related industries: introduce the current situation and trends of your country's agricultural industry development, production capacity cooperation, and explore opportunities for international cooperation.

1. Disciplinary requirements: During the implementation of the program, please strictly abide by the program schedule. During the teaching period, please observe the teaching time and teaching discipline, attendance record will be an important basis for issuing the training completion certificate. Participants are required to enter the ZOOM classroom 5 minutes early to prepare for the class. Change your personal name to English (same as your passport) name. The facilitator will mute everyone during the class. When entering the room to prepare for class, please ask the participants to turn on the video function to facilitate the roll call.

- 5. Participants are required to prepare seminar materials according to the seminar exchange schedule and submit relevant electronic materials as required.
- 6. The course is equipped with English and Chinese consecutive interpretation.

As the first national agricultural high-tech industry demonstration zone in China, Yangling Demonstration Zone has undertaken international exchange and cooperation as one of its national missions. Foreign aid training is an important way to carry out international exchange. In August 2011, the Ministry of Commerce established the China Dry Crop Agricultural Technology Training Base in Yangling, which main function is to provide foreign human resource training for developing countries.

At present, 133 foreign aid training programs for developing countries have been held in Yangling Demonstration Zone, with training topics covering cooperation in agricultural industry, poverty reduction, soil and water conservation, dry farming, modern agricultural economic management, and environmental regulation of agricultural production in dry areas, etc. A total of more than 3,300 trainees from more than 110 developing countries have participated in training in Yangling. Through training and exchange, Yangling Demonstration Zone has established cooperation with more than 60 countries around the world. Experts from Yangling Demonstration Zone have participated in many foreign aid projects of developing countries such as Ethiopia, Egypt, Cameroon, Sudan and Eritrea, providing technical support for local agricultural development and playing an important role in promoting the development of modern agriculture in local areas.

Introduction of the Organizer:

As the first national agricultural high-tech industry demonstration zone in China, Yangling is one of the areas with the greatest concentration of innovation factors such as agricultural science and technology, talents and resources, gathering more than 70 disciplines such as agriculture, forestry and water, and more than 7,000 talents in agricultural science and education. In recent years, Yangling Demonstration Zone has carried out in-depth research in basic agricultural fields such as crop breeding, environmental regulation of agricultural production, soil and water conservation, etc. Universities and research institutions in the region have cooperated extensively with research institutions in a wide range of developing countries such as Pakistan and Kenya, and have conducted in-depth discussions on common challenges facing agricultural production in developing countries, providing a broad basis for exchange and cooperation in the agricultural field.

The workshop on agricultural capacity cooperation for developing countries held in Yangling can give full play to Yangling's advantages in agricultural science and education resources, help
