Since 2012, our college has completed 315 foreign aid training programs entrusted by the Ministry of Commerce of the People's Republic of China, with a total of 10,430 participants from more than 130 countries and regions. These programs included 14 ministerial-level seminars, 16 "going global" overseas training courses with 23 classes and 92 online classes.
