- classification of general metallic minerals, rocks and minerals; (5) Introduction to China's mineral resources law: introduce the overview of The Mineral Resources Law, and the main contents of the Mineral Resources Law, and the policies of foreign investment in China's mining industry;
- (6) Factors affecting mineral development: introduce the factors of ore deposit geology and economic geography and the economic and technological factors will be involved as well.
- (7) Methods for Mineral Exploration: introduce the remote sensing prospecting method and geological, geophysical and geo-chemical prospecting method;
- (8) Modern mine design and management: introduce how to use modern management principles, functions and means to realize mineral resources development and utilization in the operation of mining enterprises;
- (9) Green mine construction system and standards: introduce the green mine construction specifications of nine major industries issued by the Ministry of Natural Resources of China, and introduce the green mine construction specifications with examples;
- (10) Mineral resources development and environmental protection: introduce influence factors of mineral resources economic value and environmental protection;
- (11) Mine land reclamation and restoration technology: introduce the reform and policy of land reclamation, as well as supervision measures to improve the reclamation and ecological restoration mechanism.
