Seminar Content	<p>The project is themed "Rural Revitalization and National Modernization", which mainly focuses the strategic deployment, policies and measures, and organizational implementation in optimizing the rural development model and accelerating the process of national modernization, shows the policy measures, implementation model, as well as experience and inspirations in rural revitalization in China, analyzes the problems and challenges faced by developing countries in promoting agricultural modernization and comprehensive rural development, building a new model of coordinated national economic and social development, and explores ways and measures to improve the rural development strategic system and implementation model. The training activities of the seminar are divided into three parts: thematic lectures, discussion exchange, and online visiting.</p> <p style="padding-left: 2em;">I. Thematic Lectures. This seminar will mainly introduce China's basic national conditions and the main achievements, strategic initiatives,</p>		

models and mechanisms, as well as experience and inspirations of China's economic and social development.

(II) Core Courses

1. Overview of rural development theory and policy. This course will mainly introduce the theoretical principles, policy requirements, practical measures, as well as experience and inspirations in rural development.

2. China's strategies and practice of rural revitalization. This course will mainly introduce the strategic deployment, policy measures, implementation mechanisms, main achievements, as well as experience and inspirations in promoting rural revitalization in China.

3. China's policies and practice of the rural modern industrial development. This course will mainly introduce the policies and measures, implementation mode, main achievements, as well as experience and inspirations in rural modern industrial development in China.

4. China's policy and practice of rural employment and development. This course will mainly introduce the policy measures, practice model, achievements, as well as experience and inspirations in promoting rural employment development in China.

5. China's policy and practice of rural science and technology development. This course will mainly introduce the policies and measures, practice model, achievements, as well as experience and inspirations in promoting rural science and technology development in China.

6. China's policies and practice of rural ecological construction. This course will mainly introduce the policies and measures, practice model, achievements, as well as experience and inspirations in promoting rural ecological construction and environmental protection in China.

7. China's policies and practices of rural public service and social security development. The course will mainly introduce the policies and measures, operational mechanisms, as well as experience and inspirations of public service supply and social security system construction in rural China.

8. China's policies and practice of the development of rural grass-roots governance system. This course will mainly introduce the policies and measures, working mechanisms, main achievements, as well as experience and inspirations in improving the rural grass-roots governance system and improving the modernization level of rural governance in China.

Notes	<p>i. This seminar uses ZOOM conference platform for online training. Participants need to have access to the Internet, a computer, a microphone, a camera and other equipment. Before the seminar, we will organize a technique test of the devices and the Internet to solve potential bugs or problems. Please take part in the test at the given time.</p> <p>ii. During the seminar, participants are requested to abide by seminar time and disciplines. Seminar completion certificates will be issued on the basis of attendance records.</p> <p>iii. About the Organizer	<p>The International Poverty Reduction Center in China (IPRCC) was established in May 2005 as one of outcomes of Shanghai Global Conference on Scaling Up Poverty Reduction in 2004. IPRCC was jointly initiated and established by the Chinese government, the UNDP, the World Bank and other international organizations,. It is designed for research, training, exchange, collaboration and knowledge sharing in poverty reduction. IPRCC is committed to the internationalization of China's poverty reduction experience, as well as the localization of global experience, so as to forge an integrated platform for poverty reduction and development. Since 2005 to the end of 2022, IPRCC has successfully held 182 seminars, with 5115 participants from 138 countries. IPRCC has developed training textbooks such as "Ten Keys to Understanding China's Poverty Reduction", video textbooks and micro video cases teaching materials. In the central and western regions in China, 15 provinces have been identified as "China Poverty Alleviation Exchange Base". Participants can be arranged to visit the bases for field visits and feel the effects of poverty alleviation policies and practices. IPRCC is also equipped with an international training team that understands business, knows foreign languages and has high quality. At the same time, it has compiled and printed the international training manual for poverty reduction, which has strengthened the standardized management and promoted the high-quality development of project implementation. IPRCC has two training classrooms with an area of 120 square meters.
