Training content introduction	<b>1. Training contents:</b> This training is dedicated to helping developing countries improve tax collection and management by introducing China's tax status and the process of tax system, sharing China's experience in improving the efficiency of tax collection and management capacity, thereby promoting tax cooperation between countries. Also participants will have chance to understand China comprehensively. Public courses mainly cover an overview of China's national conditions, development status, concepts, initiatives, and experience. The seminar will be conducted through online lectures and online discussions. The seminar will invite experts, scholars, and government officials in the field of tax capacity to give lectures to participants. All lecturers have senior titles.  <b>Online Lectures:</b> <b>(1) China's tax policy and tax system reform:</b> It mainly introduces the basic structure and characteristics of China's tax system, the relationship between taxation and economic development, social and people's livelihood, the tax system and the reform process. <b>(2) The basic system and reform and development of China's value-added tax:</b>		

	<p>This course shares with participants the establishment and development of China's VAT system and its impact on China's economy.</p> <p><b>(3) China's tariff system and reform:</b></p> <p>This course is designed to help participants fully understand the evolution and reform practice of China's tariff system.</p> <p><b>(4) International Taxation - Global Rules and Practice in China:</b></p> <p>Introduce the reform of international tax rules and systems, as well as China's participation in international tax collection and management cooperation.</p> <p><b>(5) Overview of the “Belt and Road” tax collection and management cooperation mechanism:</b></p> <p>Introduce the “Belt and Road” tax collection and management cooperation mechanism and its operational results, as well as how to strengthen tax cooperation, promote and optimize the business environment, and support trade liberalization and investment facilitation.</p> <p><b>(6) Digital transformation of tax collection and administration under the background of informatization:</b></p> <p>Introduce China’s progress in promoting the digital transformation of tax collection and administration, share China’s practical experience in promoting the construction and application of tax big data, and provide useful reference for countries to jointly promote tax collection and administration.</p> <p><b>(7) Overview of China's national conditions and achievements in the past 40 years of reform and opening up:</b></p> <p>It mainly introduces the current development status of China's politics, economy, society, culture, etc. and its achievements in the 70 years since the founding of New China and 40 years of reform and opening up.</p> <p><b>(8) China's political system and reform process:</b></p> <p>Introduce China's political system to the participants and share the reform process of China's political system.</p> <p><b>(9) Chinese History and Culture:</b></p> <p>This course aims to share the knowledge of Chinese history and Chinese culture with participants, express China to the world with "culture", and let the world understand China.</p> <p><b>(10) Implementing the United Nations 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development:</b></p> <p>China's Poverty Reduction Practice: Share the core experience of China's poverty reduction and development with the trainees, and provide useful reference for developing countries.</p> <p><b>(11) The Belt and Road Initiative and the economic and trade cooperation of developing countries:</b></p> <p>This course will focus on the detailed interpretation of the "Belt and Road" policy and the construction of the "Belt and Road" and the economic and trade development of developing countries.</p> <p>Experience, how to quickly accumulate a large amount of valuable and replicable experience in trade liberalization, investment facilitation and financial innovation.</p> <p><b>(12) Global value chain and industrial upgrading:</b></p> <p>A comprehensive introduction to domestic and foreign experience and enlightenment of</p>
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	<p>industrial transformation and upgrading relying on global value chain.</p> <p><b>2. Online Discussion &amp; Cultural Experience</b>  This seminar will arrange online discussion with Chinese experts and scholars on tax collection, taxation to promote cooperation through mutual understanding and exchanges. In addition, we will also organize traditional Chinese music online activities for participants to understand China better through the perspective of culture.</p> <p><b>3. Materials to be prepared by participants</b>  To facilitate communication with Chinese experts, please prepare materials related to the training topic in your country, such as:  (1) Introduction of your work and institution  (2) Overview of your country's tax collection, taxation and cooperation with China in this field  (3) Other topics of interest related to the training topic</p>

About the Organizer	<p>The University of International Business and Economics (UIBE), founded in 1951, is a multi-disciplinary and national key university with economics, management, law, literature and science as its core academic areas of expertise. At present, UIBE consists of 15 academic schools, a Graduate School, a campus in Israel for undergraduate studies in business administration, a Department of Physical Education and a Department of Culture and Art, offering over 1405 undergraduate courses, 875 postgraduate courses, and 109 doctoral courses. Currently, UIBE has established partnerships with over 160 overseas universities and international organizations.</p>

	<p>UIBE has been undertaking the China-Aid Foreign Official Training Programs for many years. Since 2000, under the authorization of the Ministry of Commerce, UIBE has undertaken nearly 90 bilateral and multilateral official training programs, with more than 2000 participants. The training fields mainly include economy and trade, finance, investment, taxation, customs, corporate management, law, diplomacy, etc. The training languages are English, French, Russian, Spanish, Portuguese, etc.</p>
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
