Over 40 training spots have been set in China. In 2011, International Forestry Science and Technology Training Center of the Nation Forestry and Grassland Administration (NFGA) was established at CBRC. Since 1993, CBRC organized 158 international workshops, including 9 ministerial seminars, all sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of China (MOFCOM), United Nations Development Program (UNDP).
