Disciplinary requirements: During the implementation of the project, strictly abide by the project schedule and do not organize non-training activities without authorization and withdraw from training without reason. During the teaching period, participants must comply with the teaching hours and teaching disciplines, and attendance records will be an important basis for the issuance of graduation certificates. Participants were asked to enter the team room 5 minutes early to prepare for class. Participants change their names to match their passports. During the lesson, the host will quiet everyone. When entering the room to prepare for the lesson, participants are invited to activate the video feature to facilitate roll call.</p> <p>2. This training will be conducted online through the Zoom platform or other well-known platforms. You must have internet access, computer, microphone, camera and other relevant equipment. Please contact the organizer in advance before the program starts to familiarize yourself with the platform software and to test the network.</p> <p>3. Information security: To protect the security of information and the confidentiality of personal information, please do not record, take screenshots or share them on social networks during the course. Course materials will be sent to participants at the end of the course.</p> <p>4. Participants are required to prepare workshop documents according to a special schedule of workshops and exchanges, and to submit relevant electronic documents as needed.</p>
