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About the Organizer	Yunnan International Center for Economic and Technical Exchanges (YICETE), since approved as one of training bases for international business officials by MOFCOM in 2014, has successfully organized 162 seminars sponsored by MOFCOM and People's Government of Yunnan Province, and has trained 4,113 government officials at various levels from over 102 developing countries (including 11 officials at ministerial level and 169 at

(2) He Jianlin, Associate Chief Physician of Respiratory and Critical Care Medicine Department at Affiliated Hospital of Yunnan University.

(3) Fu Xiaoqing, Director and chief physician of the Institute for the Prevention and Control of Acute Infectious Diseases of Yunnan Center for Disease Control and Prevention. Fu participated in first-line anti-epidemic work after the COVID-19 spread in Hubei and won the title of excellent medical and health personnel in Yunnan Province in 2020.

(4) Li Qiongfen, Chief physician and doctor at Yunnan Center for Disease Control and Prevention, secretary-general of Yunnan Preventive Medical Association. She has been engaged in immunization program management for a long time.

(5) Fang Jing, Director, professor, and doctor at Kunming Medical University. Fang has long been engaged in scientific research and international cooperation project management in ecological health and global health.

(6) Qin Mingfang, Deputy director and deputy chief physician of Yunnan Institute of Endemic Disease Prevention and Control. Qin has long been engaged in the management of public health emergencies, the assessment of basic public health services, and the prevention and treatment of chronic diseases.

(7) Deng Rui, Associate professor and doctor at Kunming Medical University. Deng is engaged in scientific research related to the anthropology of health and participated in evaluation of the fourth round of the people's war against AIDS in Yunnan Province and wrote the general report.

(8) Cheng Shangchao, Deputy chief physician, Yunnan Maternal and Child Health Hospital. Cheng is engaged in maternal and child health care management in the province, especially implementation of the project to eliminate AIDS, syphilis, and mother-to-child transmission of hepatitis B in China.

teaching.
