Training content introduction	<p>1. Training contents:</p> <p>This seminar will be conducted through online lectures and discussions. Public courses mainly cover an overview of China's national conditions, development status, concepts, initiatives, and experience. In view of the theme of the seminar, the specialized courses focus on Cross-border RMB Settlement, China's financial system reform and RMB internationalization. Participants will be introduced to China's development policies, concepts and strategies in related fields.</p> <p>The seminar will invite experts, scholars, and government officials in related fields to give lectures to participants. All lecturers have associate senior or senior titles.</p> <p>Online Lectures:</p> <p>1. China's financial system: Introduce the Chinese financial system, so that participants have a comprehensive understanding of China's financial development.</p> <p>2. Reform and Development of China's Financial System and Mechanism</p> <p>3. The effects of cross-border RMB settlement on bilateral trade: Explains the promotion effect of cross-border RMB settlement on bilateral trade by</p>		

	<p>introducing cases and statistics.</p> <p>4. China's interest rate liberalization reform process: Introduce the progress and prospect of China's interest rate marketization reform.</p> <p>5. The application of cross-border RMB settlement in cross-border e-commerce: Introduce participants to the application of cross-border RMB settlement in cross-border e-commerce through case studies.</p> <p>6. Implementing the United Nations 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development——China's Poverty Reduction Practice: Share the core experience of China's poverty reduction and development with participants.</p> <p>7. Overview of China's national conditions and achievements in the past 40 years of reform and opening up: It mainly introduces the current development status of China's politics, economy, society, culture, etc. and its achievements in the 70 years since the founding of New China and 40 years of reform and opening up.</p> <p>8. China's trade reform and development: This course provides a detailed overview of China's trade and the history of China's trade reform and development.</p> <p>9. Global value chain and industrial upgrading: A comprehensive introduction to domestic and foreign experience and enlightenment of industrial transformation and upgrading relying on global value chain.</p> <p>10. The "Belt and Road" Initiative——Opportunities and Challenges: This lecture will focus on the detailed interpretation of the "Belt and Road" initiative and examine the development of diplomacy among countries along the Belt and Road regions.</p> <p>2. Topic Discussion & Cultural Experience This seminar will arrange online discussion with Chinese experts and scholars on related topics to promote cooperation through mutual understanding and exchanges. In addition, we will also organize traditional Chinese music online activities for participants to understand China better through the perspective of culture.</p>

Participants are required to prepare in advance necessary equipment and devices such as internet connection, computer, microphone, camera, etc. 2. Participants should be punctual and well-disciplined. The Certificate of Completion will be issued to those who meet all the requirements including good attendance records. 3. Participants should enter the virtual classroom in advance with the screen name “NAME + COUNTRY” identical to the passport information. 4. <p>About the Organizer</p>	<p>The University of International Business and Economics (UIBE), founded in 1951, is a national key university under the leadership of the Ministry of Education. UIBE was among the first batch of higher education institutions to be listed in "Project 211" and was among the first group of China's universities to be included in the "Double First-Class" policy, and one of the most sought-after academic institutions in China and has become an important base of cultivating professional intellectuals in economy and trade and conducting scientific research. The School of Finance has a teaching and scientific research team with a reasonable structure of professional titles, academic qualifications, age and academic relationships, and potential for sustainable development. There are 92 full-time teachers, including 31 professors and 31 associate professors, with a doctorate rate of 92%. The School of Finance currently has 4 teachers with special government allowances, 1 teacher of the national "New century talents project ", 1 national "Young and Middle-aged Expert with Outstanding Contributions", and 1 national "Ten Thousand Talents Program" teacher.</p> <p>UIBE has been undertaking the China-Aid Foreign Official Training Programs for many years. Since 2000, under the authorizing of the Ministry of Commerce, UIBE have undertaken nearly 90 bilateral and multilateral official training programs, with more than 2000 participants. The training fields mainly include economy and trade, finance, investment, taxation, customs, corporate management, law, diplomacy, etc. The training languages are English, French, Russian, Spanish, Portuguese, etc. All the seminars have achieved good results. UIBE has significant advantages in foreign language majors and is one of the 15 national key foreign language universities.</p>
