Primary training courses</b></p> <p><b>General Review of China:</b> Introduce the politics, society, history, traditional culture and other aspects of China.</p> <p><b>Epidemic Prevention and Control Experience:</b> Share China’s politics and measures in fighting COVID-19, successful experiences in daily prevention and control, and international cooperation in fighting the epidemic.</p> <p><b>Poverty Alleviation and Rural revitalization in China's Rural Areas:</b> Introduce the history and achievements of poverty alleviation and Rural revitalization in China's rural areas, including poverty alleviation and Rural revitalization concepts, policy support, typical cases, etc.</p> <p><b>Overview of the world's silk industry:</b> mainly introducing the development history and current status of the world's silk technology, etc.</p> <p><b>China's sericulture technology and sericulture technology promotion system:</b> mainly introduces China's sericulture culture, development status, sericulture business model and management, etc.</p> <p><b>Modern sericulture technology:</b> mainly introducing basic technologies such as sericulture, mulberry planting, silk reeling, etc.</p> <p><b>Sericulture safety production management:</b> Introduction of management measures such as disease prevention and control and emergency management in the agricultural aspect of sericulture</p> <p><b>Cocoon silk production and management:</b> Introduction of cocoon harvesting and drying management, silk reeling technology and process, raw silk quality and monitoring, etc.</p> <p><b>Utilization of sericulture resources</b> (introduce how to develop diversified use of sericulture according to national conditions, expand the added value of the industry, etc.</p> <p><b>Introduction to the modern "Sangji Fish Pond" in China's Pearl River Delta.</b></p> <p><b>2. <p>Introduction of organizer</p>	<p>Situated in Guangzhou, “City of Flowers”, South China Agricultural University (SCAU) is one of “Double World Class” Project universities in China. With a history of 113 years, SCAU has become a multi-disciplinary university, featuring agricultural technologies and life sciences, also offers a broad range of degree programs in engineering, sciences, humanities and social sciences, management and law.
