	<p>growth.</p> <p><b>Training Content:</b> The seminar will give lectures on various topics such as an overview of China's national conditions, China's experience in reform and opening-up and economic development, Belt and Road Initiatives (BRI) and its implementation, functions of China's trade promotion organs and trade promotion system, the development trend of trade promotion and investment facilitation, the reconstruction of economic and trade rules in the context of a changing international trend, investment facilitation under the multilateral trading system, trade and investment promotion in China, characteristics of the new generation of trade and investment rules, and trade, investment facilitation for small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs), etc.</p> <p><b>Training Method:</b> The seminar will invite Chinese experts in the field of international trade in China to give themed lectures; organize discussions and exchanges between participants and experts, and among participants; organize study tours to relevant enterprises in Beijing and other cities to allow participants to experience the process of China's local economic development, witness China's achievements in investment cooperation, and feel the local customs across China.</p> <p>(The above is based on the preliminary schedule, and may be adjusted according to the actual situation. The final version will be provided upon arrival in China.)</p>
Notes	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Please prepare your passport, Chinese visa and third-party transit country visa (if necessary) before coming to China.</li> <li>2. If participants cannot depart on time due to special circumstances, or if there is a flight delay during the transfer, please contact the Economic and Trade Office or the organizer in time, inform the latest flight No. and time of arrival in Beijing so that we can arrange pick-up for you.</li> <li>3. In principle, it is not allowed for individuals to change their tickets to China. If you really need to do so, please contact the Office and follow the procedures to change your ticket. Participants who change their tickets without consent will be notified to the Chinese embassy and the costs and responsibilities therefore incurred shall be borne by yourself.</li> <li>4. After picking up the luggage, please wait patiently at the international arrival exit (or domestic arrival exit) and the organizer will pick you up with a pick-up board with your name on it. If waiting for more than 15 minutes, you can communicate with the organizer by phone.</li> <li>5.
