Introduction to the main training courses and contents (1) China’s national conditions: an introduction to the basic political, economic, cultural and social conditions of China. (2) Overview of China’s agricultural development: history of China’s agricultural development, major policies, basic conditions, challenges and future development directions. (3) Overview of the development of China’s litchi industry: history of cultivation, planting area and production, major varieties, main production areas, economic benefits, and import and export (4) Developmental biology of litchi in China: Litchi chinensis is a fruit tree native to South China and has the most Chinese characteristics. (5) Litchi production and processing techniques: breeding, high-yield cultivation, pest and disease management, fruit preservation and processing techniques, etc. (6) Orchard management: the promotion and application of advanced management tools in litchi orchards, such as standard management systems, temperature and soil monitoring and early warning systems, and integrated water, fertilizer and medicine systems. (7) Litchi marketing: brand strategy, online and offline sales linkage, creating cultural tourism boutique routes, etc. (8) Field visit: visits to litchi planting bases.
