About the Organizer	<p>The Center for International Knowledge on Development (CIKD), as an institution affiliated with the Development Research Center of the State Council (DRC), was founded in March 2017. CIKD was first announced in President Xi Jinping's speech at the 2015 UN Sustainable Development Summit calling for enhanced research and communication with other countries on development theories and practices suitable to their respective national conditions. CIKD is mandated to pool Chinese and international resources to advance development studies, undertake research on development theories and practices, and promote research and knowledge-sharing on international development issues, including the implementation of the UN 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. CIKD is officially launched in August 2017.</p> <p>CIKD serves as an important platform for researching and exchanging Chinese development experience and an important channel for sharing development experience of different countries to respond to global development challenges and to achieve sustainable development. Seminar Content	<p>This seminar includes lectures and field trips.</p> <p>All the lectures will be given by experts from the Development Research Center of the State Council of China, covering topics such as "A Brief Introduction of China", "An overview of the Development Zones in China", "China's Non-Best Development Practice", "China's Opening-up Strategy and Policies", "Ecological Progress, Ecological Civilization", "China's Green Transition", "Economic Growth and Transformation", "Transforming China's Agriculture", and "The Establishment And Development Of China's Market Economic System", etc.</p> <p>Regarding the fieldtrips, participants will be organized to visit Anyang, a historical</p>	

city in Henan Province. The arrangements will be as follows: In Anyang City, a meeting with Development Research Center of Henan Provincial People's Government with an introduction to the economic and social development of Henan Province, visits to rural areas and the Red Flag Canal, an irrigation project in Henan, etc.

In addition, at the end of the training course, a wrap up meeting on development experience of China and other developing countries or a workshop on the comparison of economic and social development in different countries will be held in Beijing, when seminar participants will give introductions on the economic and social development of their countries. One speaker from each country will give a presentation for about 10 minutes. Every participant will be required to submit a brief country report before the seminar concludes.

Through the Seminar, participants will have a comprehensive understanding of China's social and economic development, which will in turn promote further dialogues and cooperation between China and other developing countries in the future.
