The training sessions are theoretical teaching, supplemented by practical training, which comprehensively introduce Chinese police's advanced concepts and the best practices on exit-entry documents examination. The theoretical courses include General Situation of China, Judicial System in China, Police System in China, Immigration Administration in China, Technological Modernisation of Immigration Administration in China, Passport and Visa Regime in China, Questioned Document Examination in China, Passport Anti-Counterfeit Materials (Paper & Ink), Passport				

Anti-counterfeit Printing and Binding Technologies, Examination of Seal & Exit-Entry Stamps Impression in China, Face Recognition in Travel Document Examination, Examination Methods of Exit-Entry Documents of Common Countries, Collection and Analysis of Criminal Intelligence etc.

Practical training courses include Policing Chinese, Tai Chi and Calligraphy etc.

The training programme is composed of lectures, seminars and filed visits. During the training, courses on forensic science will include both theoretical lectures and practical training in laboratories.
