<p>About the Organizer</p>	<p>Jiangxi College of Foreign Studies is a co-developed college of the People’s Government of Jiangxi Province and the Ministry of Commerce of China and one of the first group of Demonstrative Vocational Colleges in Jiangxi Province. The college has been successively designated as “Jiangxi Province International Economic and Foreign Trade Personnel Training Center”, “Jiangxi Province Open-Economy Intelligence Training Center”, one of the training base for the leading cadres of the business administrative authorities from the prefecture-level cities in China, “MOFCOM Training Base for International Business Officials” and was awarded one of the Top 50 Vocational Colleges of International Influence of China.</p> <p>The college, covering an area of over 370,000 square meters, consists of 12 departments and 49 majors, including 11 foreign languages. Meanwhile, the college has a well-equipped hotel catering for training, teaching, meeting and entertainment.</p> <p>The college has been the organizer of foreign aid training projects since 2010, covering over 10 fields such as public management, energy and minerals, trade and economy, manufacturing industry, party and government, business services, water conservancy and environmental management, culture and sports, transportation and logistics, and financial industry. And these projects involve technical training courses and seminars at ministerial and director’s level.</p> <p>By the end of 2018, the college had successfully organized 148 foreign aid training projects, and had trained 3,890 international business officials from 126 developing countries, including Asia, Africa, Latin America and Europe.</p>

Seminar Content	<p>Entrusted by the Ministry of Commerce of the People’s Republic of China, Jiangxi College of Foreign Studies is to host the “Seminar on Mineral Resources Development & Management for Developing Countries” from Nov. 7th to Nov. 27th, 2019, which will be conducted in English and will last for 21 days.</p> <p>Through a combination of lectures, discussions, case studies and field trips, the seminar will be well-focused on the following topics: Introduction to Economic Geology; Distribution of World Mineral Resources; Introduction to Exploration Methods for Mineral Resources; Mineral Resources Exploration Economy; Mineral Resources Management; The Exploitation of Mineral Resources and Environmental Protection; Mining Right Management; Introduction to the Mineral Resources Law of China; Laws and Policies on Foreign-funded Exploration and Mining of Mineral Resources in China so as to share Chinese successful experience in related fields. While taking full advantages of the teaching resources of our college, we will also invite experts and scholars from Renmin University of China, East China University of Technology, and Jiangxi University of Science and Technology as lecturers.</p> <p>In addition to lectures and discussions, we will organize trip to Zhejiang Double Gold Group to explore the R&D, production, sales of complete sets of mining machinery equipment; trip to Shanghai Oriental Geological Science Museum to study the origin, distribution, collection and research of minerals; trip to Jiangxi Provincial Bureau of Geology and Mineral Exploration and Development to learn the development and management of mineral resources in Jiangxi Province.
