6 Days: 22 – 29 April 2024

3. Background

The online training under the theme of – “**Sufficiency Economy Philosophy**” or SEP is proposed to conduct by Burapha University, Chonburi, Thailand. This philosophy is an approach for sustainable development which combines the three elements of moderation, reasonableness and prudence as development framework based on two conditions of knowledge and virtue, respectively. The Philosophy stresses the importance of human development at all levels and also emphasizes the need to strengthen community’s capacity to ensure a balanced way of life and resilience, with full respect for the environment. As an approach and mind-setting framework, we believe that SEP can be applied to all 17 SDGs. Therefore, over the recent years, Thailand has shared with international community the application of SEP, our home-grown approach to sustainable development and Burapha University is one of the Thai institutions which has complied and distributed to the participants who are expected to understand and gained the knowledge as well as experiences in term of principle and the best practices in all public, private and community that adopted to their sectors.

- Currently working with at least five-year experience in above fields
- Able to participate in the online training course for the entire duration
- Sufficient command of spoken and written English language
- Computer literacy
