WORKSHOP 14-18 OCT 2019: Hospital Strategic Management

Background

In low middle income countries, implementation of effective health policies is often hampered by poor managerial and leadership capacities of hospital managers (Ham, 2003, Belrhiti et al., 2016, Belrhiti et al., 2018). Strengthening managerial and leadership capacities in healthcare organisation is essential driver of health systems performance (AHPSR, 2016, Couper and Hugo, 2005, Smits et al., 2014, Waddington et al., 2007).

Nowadays, healthcare organisations (HCO) are complex adaptive systems constrained by highly dynamic and turbulent environment (Marchal et al., 2014) (Belrhiti et al., 2018). Managing HCO requires new managerial and leadership capacities and skills(Mintzberg, 1989, Belrhiti et al., 2018, Gilson et al., 2014, Ford, 2009). They need to be able to analyse organisational performance using complexity lenses, to develop strategic adaptive plans, and to monitor implementation and change processes.

Learning objectives:

This workshop aimed at enabling healthcare managers from the Caribbean' States to assess healthcare organisational performance, craft strategic plans and manage change processes and reflect on their leadership practices. At the end of this workshop participants will be able to:

- 1. Developing a comprehensive understanding of strategic management in health systems
- 2. Assessing HCO organisational performance
- 3. Mapping HCO organisational environment
- 4. Assessing HCO organisational culture
- 5. Adapting their leadership practices to the nature of HCO
- 6. Deepening their insight about leading HCO in complex healthcare settings

Pedagogical approaches

To reach learning outcomes, we adopt a mix of experiential learning, theoretical lectures, case studies and practical hand on training toolbox.
